



U.S. Army Wounded Warrior Program (AW2)

The U.S. Army Wounded Warrior Program (AW2)

is the official Army program that serves severely wounded, injured, and ill Soldiers and their Families, wherever they are located, for as long as it takes. AW2 supports the most severely wounded Soldiers from the Global War on Terrorism who have, or are expected to receive, an Army disability rating of 30% or greater in one or more specific categories or a combined rating of 50% or greater for conditions that are the result of combat or are combat related.

AW2 assists and advocates for more than 3,300 severely wounded Soldiers and their Families. More than 120 AW2 Advocates are located throughout the country where there are large concentrations of AW2 Soldiers at VA Polytrauma Centers, VA facilities, Military Treatment Facilities, and most military installations. AW2 Advocates provide personalized, local support to Soldiers and Families for as long as it takes, regardless of their location or military status.
